

# Join the “Fire - Rescue Program” or “EMS - Rescue Program” during your Senior Year



The Harford County Volunteer Fire and EMS Association in partnership with Harford County Public Schools created a high school program to train high school seniors to become volunteer and career Firefighters and Emergency Medical Technicians. Each year high school juniors from all Harford County Public Schools are invited to apply to the Harford County “Fire - Rescue Program” and the “EMS - Rescue Program”. These programs are offered during the student’s senior year. In order to apply to this program, the student must take the Work Based Learning Program through their school, become a member of their local volunteer fire company, and submit a completed application for the program along with a 500 word essay. Students must have an average GPA of 2.5 and be prepared to complete successfully a college level program. In addition, they should have an attendance record of 90% or better and complete a physical exam satisfactorily. It is mandatory that student have their own transportation to participate.
